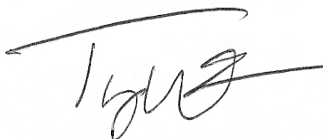
The 1<sup>st</sup> & Goal Foundation has already gotten off to a fast start, with our first official event, the “Ty Warren’s Holiday Blitz” holiday shopping spree, that was held in December 2006 in partnership with Bob’s Stores and the New England Patriots Charitable Foundation. We were able to provide 30 disadvantaged youth from a local Boys & Girls Club with a \$300 shopping spree, with the only stipulation being that each child had to purchase a winter coat. The children, all of whom were in foster care, from a single-parent home, or lived with their grandparents, were incredibly grateful. The event was a great start for our foundation, and the first of many great events to come, but as you might imagine, these events take time, effort and resources to achieve success.

The 1<sup>st</sup> & Goal Foundation has an exciting slate of events planned for 2009 and beyond, including programs like the Life Skills & Drills Clinic, being held at Bryan HS June 19<sup>th</sup> – 20<sup>th</sup>. Along with educational programs, scholarships and sports/life skills clinics, and Ty Warren’s Holiday Blitz just to name a few. The 1<sup>st</sup> & Goal Foundation is seeking contributors that share our commitment, vision and desire to make an impact in the lives of children. Meaningful help can take many forms, and whether it is a long-term or one-time commitment, all would be greatly appreciated.
